Airport Security

- Dress to blend in with the crowds
 - Don't over or under dress
 - Don't be a Typical American Tourist
- Luggage identification
 - Don't use business cards

Warning Indicators

- Perceived grievance
- Ideation of the use of violence
- Planning
- Preparation
- Breach probing behaviors
- Attack or implementation

- Fixation on the grievance
- Not moving forward
- VIEW
 - Vigilance
 - Introspection
 - Engagement
 - Willingness to act



Run, Hide, Fight

- Entering a venue or room
 - Paths of egress
 - Seat selection
- Objects of opportunity
 - Blocking or barricade
- Commit to action
 - Goal is distraction
 - Create chaos
- Run, hide, fight may not be sequential



One Second After

- Police response
- Adrenaline dump
 - ► Heightened senses for fight-or-flight
 - Increased respiration
 - Mental focus
 - Dilated pupils
 - Decreased pain sensation
- Continued EAP support
- Latent PTSD
